
ACHIEVING 350++ TREE PLANTINGS: A GREEN MILESTONE

As we continue riding mile after mile together, our commitment to the environment grows stronger. So far, we have planted over 350 trees.


Through our collective efforts, we are making significant progress toward our environmental goals, creating a meaningful impact not only on nature but also on the beneficiaries of this cause. It's also inspiring to see some of our members take up tree plantation as a personal mission, further contributing to Mother Nature.

Since the beginning of 2025, we also made a conscious effort to reduce plastic waste by minimizing the purchase of bottled water during refreshment breaks and overnight stays. By adopting the BYOB (Bring Your Own Bottle) initiative and refilling our bottles at the stay locations, we have successfully avoided purchasing at least 350 plastic bottles since we started this initiative—an encouraging step toward sustainability, even if we can't eliminate them entirely.

Thank you all for your dedication! It's amazing to see how small changes in our habits can lead to a significant positive impact on the environment.

We have completed 26 rides, covering over 16,500 km across the southern states, bringing our total cumulative distance to an impressive 3,22,879 kms.
